Once you have completed your purchases for November, you may bring your passport and receipts to the Christmas Kick-off in Grass Park on November 23, 2018 for validation and to be entered in the Grand Prize Drawing for \$500 in Chamber Bucks redeemable at any participating business along with other valuable prizes. Be sure to retain your receipts with your passport. Each time you make a purchase, enter the date, name of business and amount of purchase in the table on the inside of your passport booklet. Once your purchases total \$75 or more in a given month, you have completed that month!

Spend \$75 per month in any store in Rush County (less than \$20 per week) to be eligible for the grand prize. Purchases must be made in any retail or service business located in the county including home based businesses. (Payments for past purchases on charge accounts, utilities, mortgages, deposits into bank accounts, or payments for federal, state, or local taxes do not qualify.) Retail and service businesses must have a business address registered in Rush County.

*If every household in Rush County spent an additional \$75 per month at home, that would inject over \$1.7 million annually into the local economy.*
